Purpose of the Day-Ahead Area Operating Reserve Shortfall Report

The Day-Ahead Area Operating Reserve Shortfall Report contains operating reserve requirements, total operating reserve scheduled for each class of 10-minute operating reserve and any shortfalls in each hour, by operating reserve region for the Day-Ahead Market (DAM).

Daily after the successful completion and validation of the DAM calculation engine.

Description of the Day-Ahead Area Operating Reserve Shortfall Report Fields

Report Field Title	Definition of Report Field Title
Created at	This is the date and time that the report was created. It will be displayed as mmm dd, yyyy hh24:mm: ss.
For	This is the trade date that the DAM is optimizing for. It will be displayed as mmm dd, yyyy.
Area	This field displays the name of the operating reserve area.
Quantity	This field identifies the following quantities for each listed area:

Report Field Title	Definition of Report Field Title
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- Min. Required
- Scheduled 10S
- Scheduled 10N
- Shortfall

MW for Hour	This field displays the following MWs for each listed area:
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- Min. Required
- Scheduled 10S: sum of all 10S scheduled on generation units in the listed area
- Scheduled 10N: sum of all 10N scheduled on generation units in the listed area
- Shortfall: Min. Required – (Scheduled 10S + Scheduled 10N)

Any negative numbers will be reported as 0.
