Title: Transmission Facility All in Service Limits Report (Days 0 to 34)

Confidentiality: Public

Purpose: The purpose of this report is to list the transmission interface limits for internal and intertie transmission facilities considering All In-Service conditions

1. Created Date/Time - The date and time when the report was published
2. Limits Occurring within Content Time Period will be displayed on the report
3. Transmission Facilities Interface - Name of the impactful intertie or internal transmission facilities interface
4. Issued Date/Time - The date and time when the limit was issued
5. Start Date/Time - The start date of the All In-Service limit
6. End Date/Time - The end date of the All In-Service limit
7. Operating - This describes the operating limit in MW for the specified interface. Refer to the Ontario Transmission System document for information on the Transmission Interfaces.
8. Interchange Scheduling Limit - This describes the scheduling limit in MW as a result of the outage elements. Intertie scheduling limits consider the physical capacity of the tie-lines to transfer energy between each intertie zone and Ontario.
